To All ISoN Students,

We are updating the Camera On/Off section of the Zoom etiquette guide to improve the online learning experience for both instructors and students

Instructors use verbal cues from students to help them determine the extent to which concepts they are aiming to transmit are being received and understood by students. If instructors have access to this type of feedback, they can adapt their teaching approach. In seeing students facilitates teaching by making the experience more enjoyable and engaging. Instructors are more effective teachers when we see our students .

If an instructor uses interactive instructional methods during the class (e.g., breakout rooms, quizzes, polling) the expectation is that students participate in the learning activities to enhance their learning.
